SECOND AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACTOR AGREEMENT

This **SECOND AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACTOR AGREEMENT** (the "Amendment") is made and entered into as of June 21, 2021 to amend that certain Subcontractor Agreement dated September 1, 2019 by and between **Mercury International UK Ltd.** ("Company") and the **Mercury Public Affairs, LLC** ("Subcontractor"), as amended (the "Agreement"). Defined terms not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Agreement. The Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Relation to Prime Agreement. The Parties acknowledge that Company has entered into this Amendment with Subcontractor in order to reflect the extension of the term of a prime agreement (the "Prime Agreement") between Company and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Trade of Zimbabwe.

2. Term. The Term of the Agreement is hereby extended beginning as of May 1, 2021 and will continue in effect for one (1) year (the "Amendment Term"). The Term of the Agreement shall automatically continue on a monthly basis thereafter (the "Extension Term"), unless terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party.

3. No Other Changes. Except as modified herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
