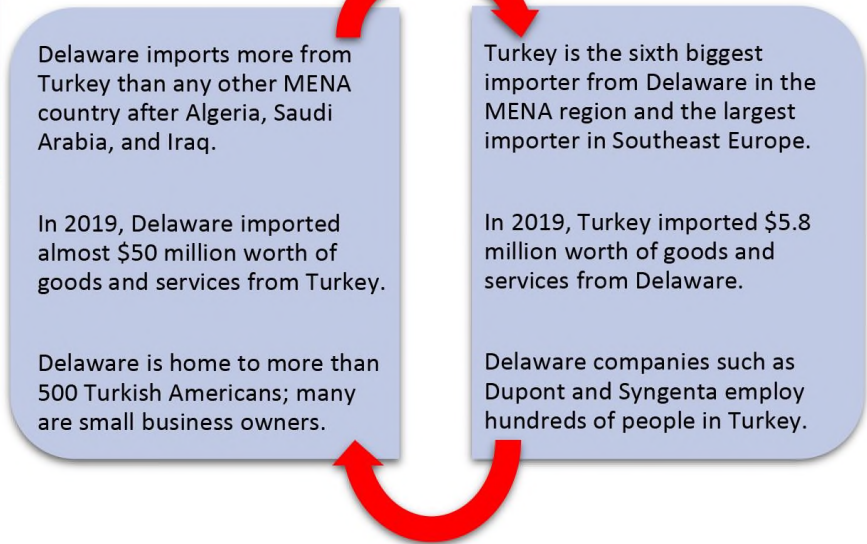


## Turkey and Delaware: A Job-Creating Economic Partnership

**Godiva: Newark**

- One of the world's most famous chocolatiers, Godiva was acquired by Yildiz Holding, a Turkish conglomerate, in 2007.
- In Delaware, they have a store and cafe in Newark's Christiana Mall, where they have around 5 employees.

Similarly, companies in Delaware have strong business partnerships, significant investments, and hundreds of employees in Turkey.




**DuPont: Wilmington**

- Based in Wilmington, DuPont is America's 35th largest company and is engaged in the agriculture, material science, and speciality product sectors.
- In Turkey, one of DuPont's high-growth markets, the company has an innovation center and around 150 employees.




**Syngenta: Wilmington**

- Syngenta is a leader amongst the US agribusiness companies, with a portfolio including seeds, crop protection and flowers. The company has more than 5,000 employees in Delaware alone.
- The company has a subsidiary in Turkey which produces medicine for crops and seeds and has 280 employees.



**Centrica: Wilmington**

- Centrica is a multinational energy and services company. It is one of the biggest employers in Delaware, with almost 5,000 employees in the state.
- Centrica owns ENER-G Cogen International Limited, a supplier and operator of combined heat and power solutions which has sales partnerships with local entities in Turkey.



**Avison: Wilmington**

- Avison is a designer and producer of image scanners and multifunction printers and has offices across the world, including in Wilmington.
- In Turkey, they sell their products and provide technical support to customers through a local partner company.
