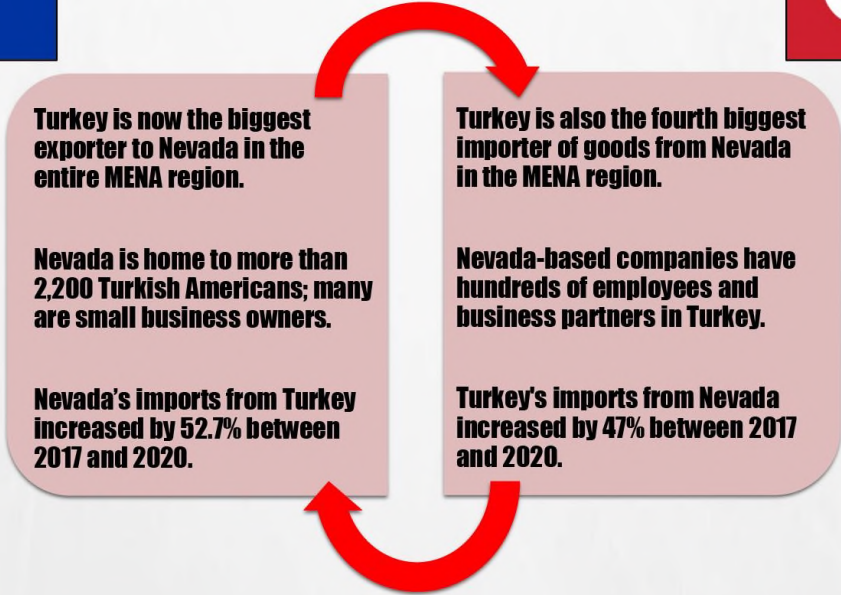


TURKEY AND NEVADA: A JOB CREATING ECONOMIC PARTNERSHIP

Ormat Technologies: Reno

Based in Reno, Ormat Technologies is a supplier of alternative and renewable geothermal energy technology. The company has more than 1,000 employees in Nevada.

In Turkey, Ormat has 38 power plant and equipment manufacturing facilities operated by hundreds of Turkish employees.

Sierra Nevada Corporation: Sparks

Sierra Nevada is aerospace and national security contractor which has contracts with the United States Armed Forces, NASA and private spaceflight companies.

The company is owned by a Turkish American couple, Fatih and Eren Ozmen, and has more than 3,000 employees in Nevada.

ESEN System Integration: Ankara

ESEN System Integration is a subsidiary of the Sierra Nevada Corporation and is based in Turkey's capital city of Ankara. The company produces systems for wide area surveillance, geolocation and monitoring, and air traffic collision avoidance.

The company has more than 200 employees and has had a number of projects in the United States.

Johnson Electric: Las Vegas

Johnson Electric is a provider of motors, actuators, motion subsystems and related electro-mechanical components for automotive, industrial and medical applications. Based in Las Vegas, the company is Nevada's fourth biggest employer with 40,000 employees in the state.

In Turkey, the company has an office in Istanbul and a partnership with a local distributor.
