



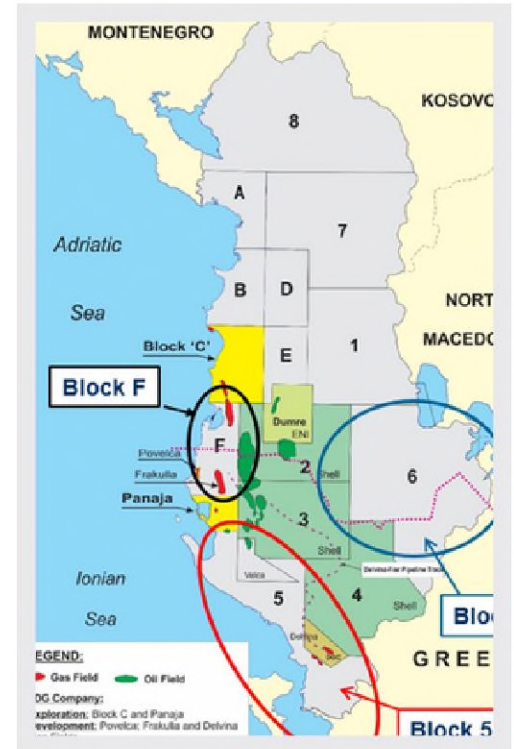
# DELVINA GAS COMPANY LTD

## ABOUT DELVINA

Delvina Gas Company is a leading independent natural gas producer operating in Albania, focused on the exploration, development, and processing of gas in the Delvina field in southern Albania.

The Delvina gas field was discovered in the late 1980's and the concession is 234 square kilometers wide. Recent exploration operations have identified possible recoverable resources of 425 billion standard cubic feet with another 500 billion cubic feet that needs to be explored on the northern side of the concession. However, natural gas exploration in Albania has historically been limited due to lack of technology, investment, and infrastructure, and the four wells drilled on the facility have fallen inactive.

Despite this, Delvina Gas Company has been active in pursuing efforts to stimulate production at the site, and recent fracking efforts have found natural gas flowing rates between 150,000 and 400,000 cubic meters per day, demonstrating the commercial potential of the Delvina reservoir. The company's goal is to drill more wells to increase the amount of gas produced at the fields and connect it to the Trans-Adriatic Pipeline so it can be shipped internationally.



## THREATS FROM ALBANIAN GOVERNMENT

In July 2025, the Albanian government arrested several Delvina Gas Company executives, alleging that the company was building a power plant without proper permission. However, concerns have been raised about the political motivations behind these arrests, and there are reports the Albanian government was pressured into making the arrests by stakeholders seeking to take control over Delvina's concession.

The Delvina executives were released due to lack of evidence, but the government has sought to squeeze Delvina by delaying permits, threatening fines, and seeking to further impede its business operations.

During these months, the principal shareholder has been subjected to senseless fines across his business holdings to block all financial activity. Delvina has waited for a field development permit for more than three years, in contradiction with the agreement signed between Delvina Gas and the government when it purchased the concession.

## REQUEST:

**Liaise with the Albanian government and request that the Rama government cease pressuring Delvina Gas Company using inappropriate methods.**

## U.S. STRAGIC INTEREST

- Current Albanian government policies are impeding U.S. investors from engaging in the Albanian energy sector.
- Albania is an emerging market in a geostrategically significant region of Europe as European countries seek to further diversify their energy resources away from Russia.
- U.S. technical expertise will be needed in all stages of development of Albania's energy sector – from exploration to development to processing – as it seeks to diversify from its traditional hydroelectric sources of power.
