A high-level Libyan delegation, headed by the Chairman of the High State Council, Minister of Finance, and other officials will be in **Washington D.C. the week of November 17<sup>th</sup>**, for a series of strategic meetings aiming to deepen ties between Libya and the United States.

They plan on meeting with U.S. government officials, business leaders, and policy experts to further establish the nations' strategic partnership in areas such as regional stability, economic growth, and global energy security. During the visit, the Libyan delegation will also be participating in a roundtable event at the Atlantic Council.

Additionally, the two sides will explore ways to expand bilateral cooperation and a robust trade and investment partnership. The delegation will further discuss the recent oil exploration announcements by BP, Shell, ExxonMobil, and others.
