7. Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

The office will engage in initiatives to promote trade and investment in Republika Srpska (RS) and to facilitate good relations between citizens and organizations of the RS and the United States (U.S.). In accordance with the RS Government's Decree on Conditions for the Establishment and Work of Representative Offices of the RS Abroad (see Exhibit C), the RS Government issued a decision to establish a representative office in the U.S. By a decree (see Exhibit C), the President of the RS appointed Obrad Kesic to head the office. The RS Ministry of Economic Relations and Regional Cooperation, on behalf of the Government, granted Mr. Kesic power of attorney for all activities related to the office's establishment and initiation of operations. It is understood that the Government will finance the physical presence of an office in Washington, salary and benefits for a director and an administrative employee, one car, and office equipment. The Government will fund three initial programs to be run from the office: investment and business opportunity promotion; outreach to and promotion of economic opportunities for RS citizens living in the U.S.; and an information program for potential investors and others interested in the RS. Two student internships will be provided. The Government will fund the office at a usual rate of \$30,000/month. These understandings are renewable by mutual consent at the end of 2013 and each successive year.

8. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

The registrant will engage in a variety of initiatives to promote trade and investment in Republika Srpska and to facilitate good relations between citizens and organizations of Republika Srpska and the United States. Among these activities will be participation in meetings, conferences, correspondence, and other communications on behalf of the foreign principal.

The registrant's activities will include contacting various Executive Branch officials, officials of Government Agencies, and Members and Staff of the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives regarding issues related to the foreign principal, including its relations with the United States, other sovereign states, and international organizations.
