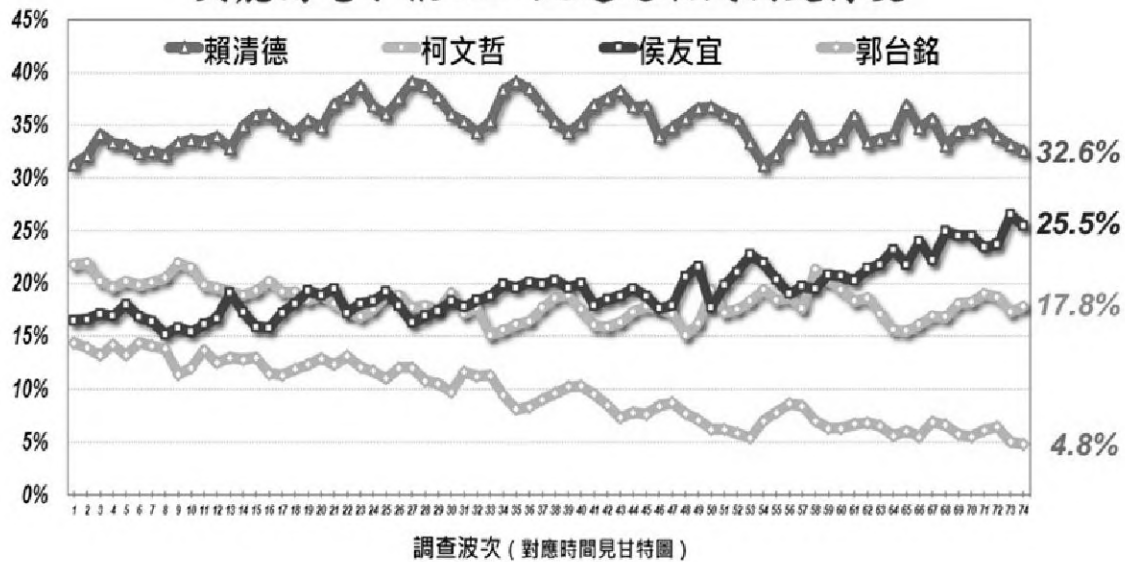

My-Formosa Poll: 2024 Presidential Election Poll from Nov. 13 to Nov. 15 (Nov. 16, 2023)

- In the My-Formosa Poll conducted from November 13 to November 15, Lai Ching-Te of the Democratic Progressive Party (DPP) leads with 32.6%, followed by Hou Yu-Ih of the Kuomintang (KMT) at 25.5%, Ko Wen-Je of the Taiwan People's Party (TPP) at 17.8%, and Terry Guo, the founder of Foxconn, as an independent candidate at 4.8%.
- The poll, which was conducted through Computer-Assisted Telephone Interviewing (CATI), successfully interviewed 1,201 people with a maximum sampling error of $\pm 2.8\%$ at a 95% confidence level, ensuring its representation of the general population's demographics and characteristics.
- This poll is one of the Taiwanese media's most cited polls, highlighting its credibility and significance in the political landscape.
