## **CCP Activates M503: Unilaterally Disrupts Status Quo, Seriously Affects Flight Safety**

- The DPP has issued a stern protest against China’s unilateral announcement to activate the M503 flight route and its connecting routes W122 and W123 for west-to-east flights.
- The actions of the CCP not only disregard the results of previous communications but also completely ignore our steadfast commitment and goodwill towards cross-strait relations, continuously altering and damaging the status quo unilaterally.
- The DPP urges the CCP to return to a normal and equal mechanism of communication across the strait as soon as possible, to handle aviation safety issues that concern the safety of life in a responsible manner, minimizing the impact on aviation and the safety of the

people, rather than persisting in unilateral actions and refusing communication, repeatedly damaging the status quo in the Taiwan Strait.
