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While there were no disbursements from the Government of Malaysia during the 60-day period prior to registration, MCKM, LLC, another company owned by Mr. White, received \$20 million in connection with a strategic services agreement with MB Consulting, a Texas-based company. Pursuant to the consulting agreement, the company agreed to provide strategic advice related to strengthening private sector commercial, economic and cultural ties between the U.S. and countries in the Asia subcontinent, particularly Malaysia, by identifying and developing investment opportunities, and investing in job-creating opportunities in U.S.-based firms in key growth areas and underserved markets. MB Consulting was owned by Mohamed Al-Husseiny (a U.S. citizen), who worked with Low Taek Jho (Jho Low). Mr. Low also served as an advisor to the Government of Malaysia, 1MDB and/or the Prime Minister of Malaysia.

Questions 7, 13, and 14(a).

DuSable Capital Management, LLC (DuSable) previously reported that its connection to 1MDB/Government of Malaysia ended on 10/02/2014. As disclosed in the prior filing, on October 2, 2014, the private equity fund managed by DuSable entered into an agreement to sell its joint venture in the solar project to 1MDB in anticipation of an initial public offering of 1MDB's energy assets. Proceeds of that sale have been and will be distributed to DuSable and its limited partners pursuant to the fund's subscription agreement and other agreements with the limited partners.

DuSable sold its joint venture in the solar project to 1MDB for \$69 million. Final payment for the sale was not received until June 2015. As previously disclosed, proceeds were distributed to DuSable and its limited partners pursuant to the fund's subscription agreement and other agreements with the limited partners.
