11. With respect to Republic of Congo and Prof. Mboyo-Di-Tamba Vangu, Dickens & Madson engaged in various political activities. Specifically those activities were verbal communications at meetings with Israeli intelligence and with Vatican officials (through the former archbishop of Kinshasa, Laurent Monsengwo Pasinya), to attempt to persuade Israel and the Vatican to exercise influence over the government of the United States. The political end or aim of those efforts was (a) to remove the influence of Joseph Kabila derived from positions from which he is able to exercise political power within Congo notwithstanding that he is no longer president and (b) to empower Dickens & Madson's foreign principals as representatives or potential representatives of the people of Congo going forward. Those communications were in the form of both telephone calls and in person meetings. They did not take place within the United States.

With respect to the foreign principals associated with Libya, Dickens & Madson engaged in activities that were related to, but not designed or intended to influence, policy within the United States with respect to Libya and which were related to the interests of the Dickens & Madson foreign principals. Specifically, at the request of the government of the United States, Dickens & Madson, through Mr. Ari Ben-Menashe, had verbal communications with Prime Minister Serraj at a meeting in Malta and with Khalifa Haftar to arrange a meeting between the two of them in Russia in an attempt to reduce tensions and decelerate military escalation within Libya. Prime Minister Serraj was unwilling to participate and the effort was abandoned.

With respect to West Papua, Dickens & Madson did not engage in political activity as to the United States but worked to secure housing and infrastructure assistance from other sources through activities outside of the United States.
