Supplemental Statement Dickens & Madson Canada, Inc.

11. During the 6 month reporting period Dickens & Madson provided the following services to each of the foreign principals listed below:

With respect to Progressive Advance, Dickens & Madson has continued to assist the principal by working toward a compromise in which Nicolas Maduro and Henri Falcon would agree to the invalidation of the results of the most recent presidential election by the Supreme Court of Venezuela to enable a repeat of the election. In furtherance of this project, Dickens & Madson has sought confirmation that the government of the United States of America will not oppose the plan provided that Maduro discontinues his claim to the presidency of Venezuela. During the course of this work Dickens & Madson has maintained regular, ongoing telephone communications with U.S. intelligence and the executive branch of the United States of America for the purpose of keeping the government of the United States apprised of the status of Dickens & Madson's activities and assuring their consistency with U.S. interests and policy priorities.

With respect to Republic of Congo and Prof. Mboyo-Di-Tampa Vangu, Dickens & Madson has continued to communicate with Laurent Monsengwo Pasinya, Prof. Vangu and Felix Tshisekedi to attempt to implement a transition to a government for Republic of Congo free from the influence of former president Joseph Kabila. During the course of this work Dickens & Madson has maintained regular, ongoing telephone communications with U.S. intelligence and the executive branch of the United States of America for the purpose of keeping the government of the United States apprised of the status of Dickens & Madson's activities and in order to act in alignment with U.S. interests and policy priorities.

With respect to the Transitional Council of Sudan, Dickens & Madson has continued to provide advice and guidance to the foreign principal regarding the implementation of a transition to civilian rule, has worked with the foreign principal to investigate and explore the viability and desirability of a Sudanese union with South Sudan, and has assisted in facilitating a new operator for Port Sudan. During the course of this work Dickens & Madson has maintained regular, ongoing telephone communications with U.S. intelligence and the executive branch of the United States of America for the purpose of keeping the government of the United States apprised of the status of Dickens & Madson's activities and in order to act in alignment with and/or to implement U.S. interests and policy priorities.

As to Christopher Siriosi, Dickens & Madson has assisted to carry out a referendum on Bougainville independence and provided guidance with respect to the creation a stable, credible independent government. Dickens & Madson has also worked to facilitate the operation of Bougainville mining operations by a credible U.S.-based operator and to facilitate financial support for an independent Bougainville. During the course of this work Dickens & Madson has maintained regular, ongoing telephone communications with U.S. intelligence and the executive branch of the United States of America for the purpose of keeping the government of the United States apprised of the status of Dickens & Madson's activities and for the purposes of furthering the interests of the United States with respect to Bougainville.

With respect to United Liberation Movement for West Papua, Dickens & Madson has worked with the government of the Russian in Federation with respect to pursuing autonomy but has not directed any activities towards the United States.

As to Nabil Karoui, Dickens & Madson provided guidance with respect to the policies and objectives of the United States concerning the Tunisian election. During the course of this work Dickens & Madson maintained regular, ongoing telephone communications with the United States government in order to advise Karoui, but not for the purpose of altering United States policies.
