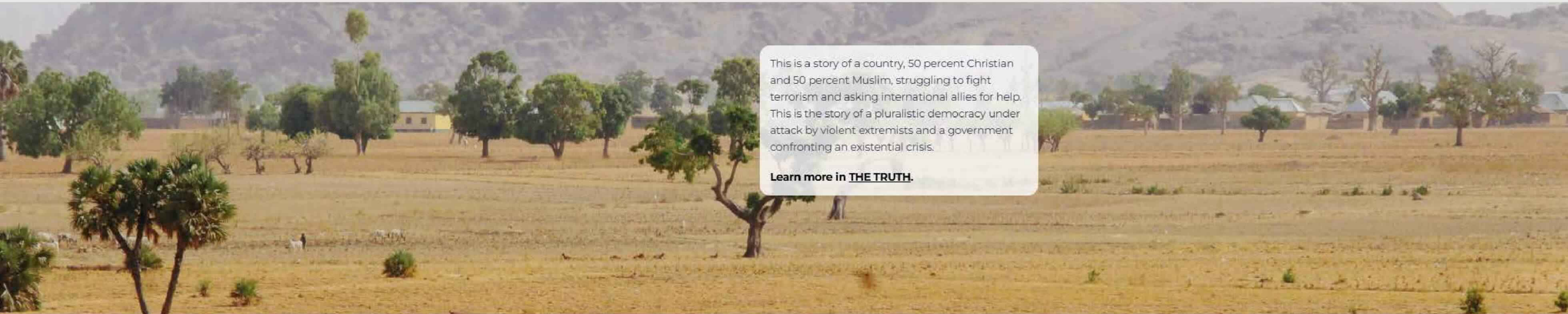
Nigeria's security crisis is national in scope, and the government is confronting it as such.
