Contract

Mr. KAWAKAMI Kyoichiro, Minister at the Embassy of Japan (hereafter referred to as A), acting on behalf of Japan and in accordance with the authority vested in him, and Greenfield Law, LLC (hereafter referred to as B), have agreed as follows with respect to certain activities to be provided by B:

1. B pledges to provide, upon request from A, advice and assistance in connection with the normal business of the Japanese Embassy and other matters as required, as well as information of relevance.
2. The period of the contract shall be from April 1, 2026 to April 11, 2026. Upon coming into force of the budget of the government of Japan for the fiscal year 2026, the contract term shall be extended to March 31, 2027.
3. A shall pay B \$3,104 for the service from April 1, 2026 to April 11, 2026. In case that contract term is extended to March 31, 2027, the fee for service from April 1, 2026 to March 31, 2027 shall be \$103,000. A shall pay B \$25,750 at the end of each quarter.
4. B must not divulge any confidential information learned through association with A, neither during nor after the period of this contract, unless required to do so by law.
5. This contract is without prejudice to any renewal or continuation of contract for a year that follows.
6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, either party may cancel this contract by issuing notification 30 days in advance.

In witness whereof, the parties hereto have caused this contract to be executed in duplicate originals, one original to be retained by each party.
