**Contract**

**The undersigned parties to this Contract:**

**1) Robert K. Kelley (hereafter "RK", with an address at 1401 K St. NW, Suite 400, Washington DC 20005 USA).**

**2) The party, (hereafter "party").**

**Hereby agree in consideration of the mutual promises given here, and which have been received:**

**1. Services:**

**RK will advocate the goals and means to those goals of party before the U.S. Government and private sector, including**

- the Executive Branch, including the White House, Department of State, Department of Defense and other Agencies**
- the Legislative Branch, including the Senate and the House of Representatives, including Staff of the Legislative Branch**
- the policy community in Washington DC and in the US**
- the Media in the US**

**Party will keep RK currently informed of Party goals and measures so that RK can advocate these before US Government and private sector as above.**

**2. Term: The term of this Agreement shall be six (6) month, beginning on January 15, 2016 and concluding on July 15, 2016. Either party may terminate this Agreement without further liability to the other party by giving 30 days prior written notice of such termination.**

3. **Compensation:** RK will receive \$15,000 per month, payable every two months in the amounts of \$30,000 on January 15, March 15, and May 15.
4. The first payment is due upon the signing of this Agreement.
5. This and all future payments will be transferred electronically in United States dollars to RK's account at Capital One Bank. The specifics of the account will be provided in a separate document.

~~S~~ 7. **Expenses over \$1,000:** RK shall obtain written approval from party (email or electronic communications shall suffice) for any extraordinary expenses over \$1000. For any expenses over \$1000, approved by party, party shall pay in advance an estimated amount up to ninety percent of the amount stated on a written estimate and submitted to party, with settlement of the remaining amount within 30 days of the services for which the expense is made. RK

8. **Expenses under \$1,000:** Party agrees to reimburse RK for reasonable out-of-pocket expenses and travel expenses that may be required in connection with the performance of services. Any expenses required (including lodging, meals, parking, etc) shall be reimbursed by Party upon submitting an invoice listing such expenses to Party.

All fees to RK for services shall be due and payable within 30 days.

9. **Limitations:** Nothing in this Agreement shall grant to either party the right to make commitments of any kind for or on behalf of the other party without prior written consent of the other party.

10. **Independent Contractor:** RK will act as an independent contractor and not as an employee or agent of party.

**11. Compliance with US law:** RK in providing services to party shall at all times comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws. RK shall comply in all respects with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations of the United States.

**12. Notices:** All notices, requests, instructions, or other documents required hereunder shall be deemed to have been given or made when delivered by registered mail or certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid or other reputable overnight mail delivery or courier service to the addresses stated at the outset of this Contract.

**13. Governing Law:** This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of the District of Columbia and the United States.

**14. Entire Agreement:** This Agreement contains the entire understanding between the parties hereto and supersedes all prior written and oral understandings relating to the subject matter hereof. Any modification of or amendment to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties in order to be enforceable.


