Re: Engagement Letter with theGROUP DC

Dear Ambassador Harper:

I am pleased the Government of Guyana ("Client"), has engaged theGROUP DC, LLC, ("theGROUP") to provide assistance, advice and counsel, and advocacy on matters of interest to the Client before the legislative and executive branches of the U.S. Government. In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Term** This Agreement shall commence on September 1, 2023, (the Effective Date) and continue for six (6) months (the "Initial Term"). Following the Initial Term, this Agreement shall automatically renew for successive six (6) month periods, unless either party provides written notice to the other party, no later than thirty (30) days prior to the end of the term, of its intent to not renew.
- 2. Fees & Expenses** In return for the Services, Client agrees to pay theGROUP the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per month. The fees shall be payable quarterly, in advance, with the first payment due upon execution of this Agreement. theGROUP will invoice Client each quarter and such invoices shall be due and payable upon receipt. Subject to Client's prior approval and upon submission of appropriate documentation from theGROUP, Client will reimburse to theGROUP those non-local business-related travel and other expenses reasonably and necessarily incurred in connection with the performance of the Services. Such pre-approved expenses will be billed monthly and shall be reimbursed promptly upon receipt of invoice.
- 3. Confidentiality** During the course of this Agreement, each party may come into the possession of Confidential Information (as defined below) that pertains to the other party's

or its third-party consultants' businesses, including strategies and procedures. As used herein, "Confidential Information" shall mean a party's proprietary, confidential information and data, other than information which is: (i) in the public domain; (ii) known to the other party at the time of disclosure; or (iii) disclosed to one party hereto by a third party under no obligation of confidentiality to the other party hereto.

Confidential Information shall not be divulged or made accessible to any third party without the other party's written consent or pursuant to a court order. In the event that any confidential information is inadvertently disclosed, the disclosing party shall immediately notify the other party.

- 4. Indemnification** Client shall indemnify and hold harmless theGROUP, its affiliates and successors, assigns, officers, directors, and employees from and against any and all claims, actions, damages, liabilities, losses, costs, or expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees), which may arise in connection with Client's negligent or willful acts or omissions in connection with this Agreement or Client's non-compliance with any applicable laws, rules, regulations, statutes, legal requirements, or Client policies. For the avoidance of doubt this Section shall survive termination of this Agreement.
- 5. Notices** All notices, requests, demands, claims and other communications hereunder related to the terms of this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be given or made (and shall be deemed given or made upon receipt) by delivery in person, by courier service, by email, by telecopy or by registered mail (postage prepaid, return receipt requested) to the respective parties at the following addresses (or to such other addresses as may be notified by one party to the other in writing):

- 7. Entire Agreement** This Agreement and any Exhibit(s) attached hereto constitute and are intended to constitute the final, entire, complete, and exclusive agreement between the

parties. This Agreement may be modified or amended only by mutual, written agreement of the parties.

8. **Authority** Each party represents and warrants that it has power to enter into this Agreement on behalf of Client and theGROUP respectively and has obtained all of the necessary approvals to do so.

If you have any questions about the terms described above, please let me know. Once again, on behalf of theGROUP, we appreciate the opportunity to represent the Government of Guyana.
