Re: Agreement between Cornerstone Government Affairs and Yayasan Berbakti Semangat Indonesia for Government Relations Services

Dear Erwin Aksa,

Please find this letter as the formal agreement ("**Agreement**") between Cornerstone Government Affairs, Inc ("**Cornerstone**") and Yayasan Berbakti Semangat Indonesia ("**YBSI**") referred to individually as Party or Parties collectively, for government relations ("**Services**") as outlined below and conducted according to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

Scope of Services

During the Term, Cornerstone shall provide Services to YBSI. The precise scope and extent of the Services may be amended by mutual agreement of the Parties but generally focus on:

Federal Government Relations

- Developing a strategic federal lobbying engagement plan with key Members and staff, including issues management, that identifies key priorities and messaging on matters of importance to the organization including:
 - Creating a favorable trade and business environment;
 - Enhancing U.S.-Indonesia trade bonds; and
 - International development and economic investment;
- Engaging with key congressional members and staff of the following committees on YBSI's behalf:
 - House and Senate Appropriations Committees;
 - House Foreign Affairs Committee;
 - Senate Foreign Relations Committee;
 - House Ways and Means Committee;
 - Senate Committee on Finance;
 - Democratic and Republican leadership in the House and Senate as well as the next generation of House and Senate leadership, and future committee chairs; and
 - Members with a vested interest in Indonesia; and
 - California congressional delegations with large Indonesian diaspora;
- Working with the Administration by engaging with the following relevant departments and agencies:
 - Department of State;
 - Department of Commerce; and
 - United States Trade Representative;
- Providing strategic engagement and advisory services, intelligence gathering, and issue monitoring on legislative and Administration developments of interest;
 - Performing ongoing political and policy analysis;



- Identifying and supporting opportunities for enhanced engagement with the Administration and the remainder of the 118th Congress and continue to set up and position you for success with a new Administration and the 119th Congress;
- Gathering and sharing intelligence on legislative and Administration action of interest to YBSI, on an as-needed basis, including but not limited to, regular calls and updates on issues and developments of strategic importance to the organization;
- In collaboration, developing a mapping process that would include:
 - Development of materials and planning of meetings and events that build deeper and broader understanding of policy objectives; and
- Exploring partnerships with other non-governmental organizations.

Term

The term ("*Term*") of the Agreement shall begin on the date both Parties have executed this Agreement and continue for 12 months. Either Party may terminate this Agreement with or without cause at any time during the Term with immediate effect following written notice to the other Party.

Fee, Administrative Fee, and Expenses

The payment for the scope of services shall be made in twelve (12) payments of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00) plus reasonable and customary out-of-pocket expenses with any travel being approved in advance by YBSI (the "*Fee*"). Cornerstone shall invoice YBSI for the first payment upon the execution of this Agreement and will otherwise invoice the Fee at the beginning of each subsequent quarter through the remainder of the Term. The Fee due under such invoice shall be payable within thirty (30) days after YBSI's receipt of the invoice. In the event that YBSI exercises its right to terminate this Agreement, YBSI shall be obligated to pay only those fees and expenses that have accrued and are due and payable up to the effective date of termination, and shall not be liable for any fees or expenses beyond that date.

Performance Standards

Cornerstone shall meet professional performance standards applicable to its industry in delivering the Scope of Services, including the highest business ethics.

Quality Assurance

Cornerstone shall implement and maintain the following quality assurance processes to ensure the quality of services delivered: (a) Regular internal reviews of deliverables before submission to Client. (b) Adherence to industry best practices and standards relevant to the services provided. (c) Ongoing training and development of staff involved in service delivery. (d) Periodic client satisfaction surveys and incorporation of feedback into service improvement initiatives. Cornerstone shall provide Client with a report on these quality assurance measures upon request.

Confidentiality

Cornerstone shall maintain confidentiality with regard to information marked or expressly identified as confidential by YBSI at the time of disclosure ("*Confidential Information*"). Confidential Information shall only be used by Cornerstone employees or authorized agents in the performance of obligations in this Agreement. Cornerstone shall not disclose any Confidential Information to any person or entity without the prior express written consent of YBSI.

In the event that such disclosure is required by law, regulation or court order, Cornerstone agrees, if reasonably practicable, to refrain from such disclosure until such time as YBSI has received written notice



with regard to any required disclosure (provided that notice of the required disclosure is not prohibited by law), and YBSI has had a reasonable opportunity to contest the basis for disclosure and review the content of the proposed disclosure.

Liability

The entire liability of Cornerstone, and YBSI's exclusive remedy for damages from any cause related to or arising out of this Agreement, regardless of the form of action, whether in contract or in tort, shall not exceed the amount of monies actually paid to Cornerstone by YBSI in the immediately preceding twelve (12) month period. Cornerstone will not be liable for any incidental, indirect, special, or consequential damages, including but not limited to, loss of use, revenues, profits, or savings, even if Cornerstone knew or should have known of the possibility of such damages or claims against YBSI by any person.

Indemnity

YBSI agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Cornerstone against all losses, claims, damages, legal fees, expenses, or liabilities that Cornerstone may incur based upon information, representations furnished or approved by YBSI or its authorized representatives, whether or not Cornerstone prepared or participated in the preparation of such materials. Cornerstone agrees to indemnify and hold harmless YBSI against all losses, claims, damages, legal fees, expenses, or liabilities that YBSI may incur based upon information, representations, or releases made by Cornerstone or its authorized agents that YBSI did not expressly approve, or that Cornerstone materially changed or altered after YBSI's approval; or that Cornerstone used in a negligent or reckless manner. This paragraph shall survive the termination of this Agreement and shall continue to bind both Parties.

Compliance

Each Party shall be responsible, at its own expense, for complying with any US federal, state, or local law covering the representation of foreign principals, specifically, but not limited to, the Foreign Agents Registration Act (FARA). YBSI understands that activities may require regular disclosure with the Department of Justice, including fees and expenses paid to Cornerstone. YBSI warrants that it has provided Cornerstone with accurate and complete information concerning its ownership, funding, and objectives and will notify Cornerstone immediately should any of this information change.

Governing Law

This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the District of Columbia, without giving effect to any choice of law provision or rule.

Amendment

This Agreement may be changed by written agreement signed by each Party.

Delegation and Assignment

YBSI is entitled to assign its rights and obligations under this Agreement to a third party with thirty (30) days prior written notice to Cornerstone. Cornerstone shall not assign its rights and obligations without YBSI's written consent.
