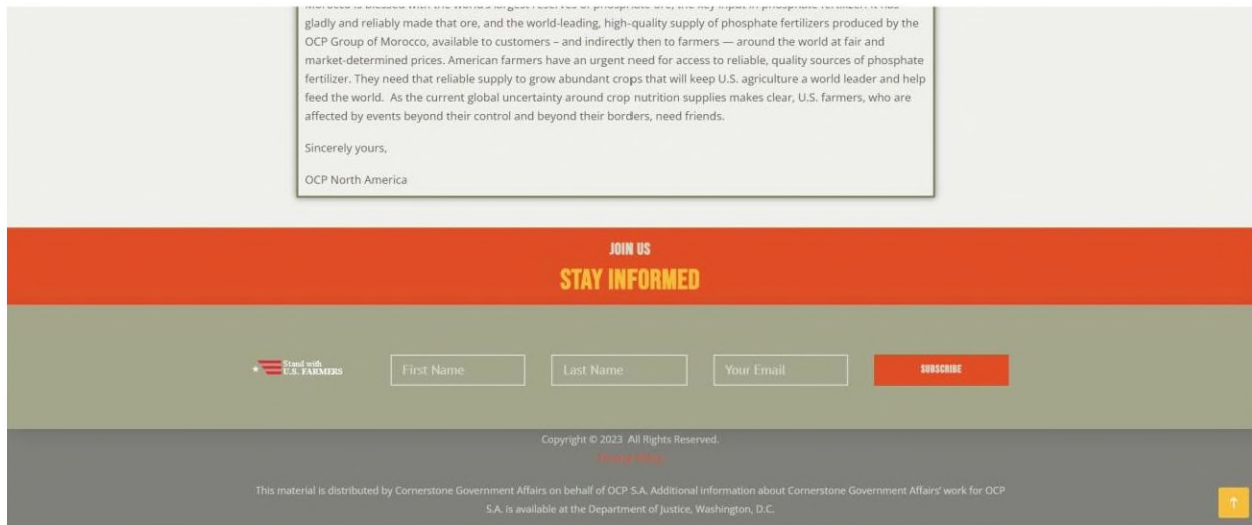


In the attachment, "OCP Site Updated Footer", the FARA disclaimer was updated to reflect the change in site management from Cogent to Cornerstone.
