While Naftogaz is the national oil and gas company, it has moved since 2015 to institute corporate structures, promote industry best practices and good corporate governance. The joint stock company is continuing its efforts on corporate governance reforms which designed to insulate Naftogaz from political influence.


A significant portion of the funding for Naftogaz is subsidized through domestic government bonds. The company is headed by a former PriceWaterhouseCooper (PwC) management consultant who is working to institute best practices from the global O&G industry.


