

Dear Telia:

This contract outlines the role, scope of work, and specific financial and billing terms of the US Africa Development Corporation (USADC) for the services to be rendered to Mr. Urey.

It is understood that this contract is binding and is governed by U.S. legal terms and conditions that have been discussed and agreed to by you, as an authorized representative or agent of Mr. Urey, and the USADC. Should a dispute arise, this matter will be resolved via binding arbitration as defined by the American Association of Arbitration. The venue for any such arbitration shall be Washington, D.C.

During the term governed by this agreement (February 2, 2017-November 1, 2017), the USADC will provide support to Mr. Urey in accordance to our verbal agreement and discussions.

It has been agreed that you will compensate the USADC a professional fee. This fee shall be a of total \$210,000 (USD), which includes a travel budget of \$10,000. Payment of this fee is as follows:

-\$50,000 shall be due upon the signing of this document via wire, (wiring information listed on page 2);

-\$160,000 balance will be paid in monthly increments of \$20,000 per month for the remaining eight months with the first payment due within 60 days of from the signing of this document (April 2017) with the balance to be paid on/or before November 2, 2017.

All normal expenses (except for international travel as requested by Mr. Urey,) shall be absorbed by the USADC. Any travel beyond the initial travel for meetings abroad shall be requested to be paid for by the campaign. Such travel will be discussed in advance and approved by the campaign.

Additionally, the USADC shall be due 30 percent of the funding/contribution income as generated, directly or indirectly, by Mr. Urey's campaign or his agents or representatives. A funding accounting shall be provided to the USADC upon request.

We look forward to working for Mr. Urey and the campaign.


