## Amendment to Registration Statement Pursuant to the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended

Registrant was engaged by VantageKnight on January 23, 2017, to assist it in providing policy and government affairs advice to and for Citgo Petroleum Corporation in support of engagement efforts with the Legislative and Executive Branches of the U.S. government, specifically with respect to the potential impact of U.S. and foreign policy restrictions on Citgo Petroleum Corporation's operations and valuation of assets. Registrant disclosed this engagement, which terminated on or before April 20, 2020, under the Lobbying Disclosure Act. See 22 U.S.C. 613(h).

With the appointment of the Ad Hoc Board of PDVSA on approx. Feb. 18, 2019, it is possible that PDVSA's indirect ownership of Citgo Petroleum Corporation may have rendered Citgo Petroleum Corporation an agent of the Ad Hoc Board of PDVSA under the Department of Justice's interpretation of the Foreign Agents Registration Act. Thus, Registrant is filing Exhibits A and B and a short form on the theory that FARA applied on and after the appointment of the Ad Hoc Board of PDVSA.
