This document amends the Foreign Agents Registration Act filings noted below as required by the terms of the Deferred Prosecution Agreement of December 28, 2023 in the matter of *United States v. Bennett*, as supplemented by Department of Justice instructions of December 13, 2024, and various dates thereafter up to the date the Department of Justice approved the proposed amendments:

September 18, 2017 FARA Filing (Exhibit B)

The block at Question 4 should have been checked.

Amend Exhibit B, Question 7 to read as follows: "The contract was filed on September 18, 2017. The contract was amended to show that Registrant will also offer strategic public relations counsel and support to advantage Qatar by bringing attention to the humanitarian and health crisis occurring as a result of the Saudi Arabia/UAE blockade in Yemen."

March 2, 2018, FARA Filing (Supplemental Statement for the six-month period ending January 31, 2018)

1. Amend Answer to Question 11 on the Supplemental Statement for the six month period ending January 31, 2018 (filed March 2, 2018) to add: "Registrant also offered strategic public relations counsel and support to advantage Qatar by bringing attention to the humanitarian and health crisis occurring as a result of the Saudi Arabia/UAE blockade in Yemen."
2. Amend Answer to Question 12 to add:
 - a. "Yemen Watch was created on September 6, 2017 by Doug Watts with assistance from the law firm Calfe Halter & Griswold LLP. Barry Bennett directed Doug Watts to create Yemen Watch and proposed that Bennett 'manage the entire project quietly.' Bennett also introduced Watts to a Calfee partner."
 - b. "Doug Watts performed work on ASG's contract with Qatar through his affiliation with Yemen Watch. Watts also hired (or contracted) others to perform work related to this contract."
 - c. "Registrant had some limited knowledge that a Yemen Watch briefing was planned to be held on Capitol Hill. Mr. Bennett did not attend the event, which was funded by Yemen Watch, an organization funded by ASG."
 - d. "Registrant caused a letter from Reverend Robert Schuller to be submitted to a White House employee via email at the request of Doug Watts. The letter was to advantage Qatar by bringing attention to the humanitarian crisis in Yemen."
