The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to set forth the terms of the business relationship between the Circle of Democrats and Republicans of Congo (CDRC) and Avenue Strategies Global, LLC (ASG).

ASG will represent the CDRC in opposition to the current government in Congo, as well as represent the CDRC to the United States Government. For the United States Government representation, ASG will file in accordance with the Foreign Agents Registration Act (FARA) with the U.S. Department of Justice.

The cost of these services will be for \$25,000 per month and the term of the relationship will be for one year, effective starting on February 26, 2018, and terminating on February 26, 2019.
