

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF
STRATEVARIOUS, LLC

The undersigned, pursuant to Chapter 12 of Title 13.1 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, state as follows:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the limited liability company is **StrateVarious, LLC**.

ARTICLE TWO

A. The physical address of the limited liability company's initial registered office in Virginia is: 821 Long Mountain Road, Washington, Virginia 22747.

B. The registered office is physically located in the County of Rappahannock, Virginia.

ARTICLE THREE

A. The name of the limited liability company's registered agent is S. Enders Wimbush whose address is identical with the initial registered office.

B. The registered agent is a member of the limited liability company and a resident of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ARTICLE FOUR

The post office address of the principal office where records will be maintained pursuant to Virginia Code Section 13.1-1028 is: 821 Long Mountain Road, P.O. Box 205 Washington, Virginia 22747.

ARTICLE FIVE

Any operating agreement entered into by the members of the company, and any amendments or restatements thereof, shall be in writing. No oral agreement among any of the members or managers of the company shall be deemed construed to

constitute any portion of, or otherwise effect the interpretation of, any written operating agreement of the company, as amended and in existence from time to time.

ARTICLE SIX

The company shall be a "manager-managed limited liability company" within the meaning of the Act, and no member of the company, solely by reason of such member's membership in the company, shall be considered or relied upon to be an agent of the company for the purpose of binding the company with respect to any transaction or other obligation whatsoever.

ARTICLES SEVEN

In any proceeding brought by or in the right of the company or brought by or on behalf of its members, no manager or member shall be liable to the company or its members for any monetary damages with respect to any transaction, occurrence, course of conduct, or otherwise except for liability resulting from such managers or members having engaged in willful misconduct or a knowing violation of the criminal law, or except as otherwise expressly provided by the applicable laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia or any written operating agreement of the company in effect from time to time.
