SAPRAC also organized meetings between the MWL delegation and U.S. Department of State officials, including Ambassador at Large for International Religious Freedom Sam Brownback, detailing efforts taken by the MWL that correlate to uphold U.S. policy goals of promoting religious tolerance and counter-extremism efforts.

## ENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT

This **ENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT** ("Agreement") is effective this April 23, 2018 (the "Effective Date"), by and between the Muslim World League (MWL), with headquarters at Makkah Al-Mukarramah - Omm al Joud, Old Jeddah Road, PO BOX 537, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia ("Client") and the Saudi American Public Relation Affairs Committee, Inc. ("SAPRAC") with office at 1101 30th Street NW, Suite 315, Washington DC 20007 ("Provider"). The Client and the Provider are hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties" and separately as a "Party."

**WHEREAS**, Client and Provider wish to memorialize the terms and conditions set forth herein and formalize their agreement to have the Provider perform the Services, as hereinafter defined; and **WHEREAS**, the Provider is willing to perform the Services and the Client is willing to pay for the Services, as set forth herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed as a guarantee or warranty, either express or implied, on the part of either Party that
