

FIRST ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE EMBASSY OF HONDURAS IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND YORKTOWN SOLUTIONS

This Addendum is made and entered into this 2nd day of January 2022, by and between the Ministry of Foreign Relations and International Cooperation, through the Embassy of Honduras in the United States of America ("EOH"), located at 1220 19th St. NW, Suite 320, Washington, DC 20036 and Yorktown Solutions, LLC ("YTS"), a strategic and political risk advisory firm with offices located at 601 Thirteenth Street NW, Suite 900 South, Washington, D.C. 20005, provides for extension of the agreement until January 26, 2022.

RECITALS

- A. **WHEREAS** the Embassy of Honduras in the United States of America ("EOH") and Yorktown Solutions, LLC ("YTS") entered into an agreement for advisory services dated October 26, 2022.
- B. **WHEREAS** the parties desire to extend the term of the current contract for additional time to January 26, 2022; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to modify the parts of the agreement as set forth below.

AGREEMENT

1. Section 2 of the Agreement, dated October 26, 2021 is hereby amended to extend the contract termination date from December 31, 2021 to January 26, 2022.
2. Except as otherwise provided herein all terms and conditions of the agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
