

<p><b>Additional agreement #2 to Information Services Contract #1M dated the 1st of April 2023</b></p> <p style="text-align: right;">_____ 2025</p> <p>This Additional agreement #2 to Information Services Contract #1M dated the 1st of April 2023 (Contract) is made as of the "_____" 2025 ("Effective Date") between the Primary Trade Union Organization of National Nuclear Energy Generating Company "Energoatom," a legal entity, duly registered and acting under the laws of Ukraine, represented by Serhii Snitkov, Head of the Primary Trade Union Organization, acting based on the Charter, located at 2, Maidan Nezalezhnosti, Kyiv, 01001, Ukraine, and Yorktown Solutions LLC, a strategic advisory firm, established and acting under the laws of the United States, represented by Daniel Vajdich, President, duly empowered pursuant to the Articles of Organization, located at 444 North Capitol Street NW, Suite 613, Washington, D.C. 20001.</p> <p>Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants the parties agree as follows:</p> <p>1. Paragraph 3.1. point 3 of Contract should be set out in the following version: «3.1. The price of this Contract and price of Services is USD 960 000 (Nine hundred sixty thousand) for the Period of provision of services, taking into account the provisions set out in Paragraph 5.1. Currency of payment is USD.</p> <p>2. Paragraph 5.1. Point 5 of Contract should be set out in the following version: «5.1. The period of provision of the Services is 12 months. The Parties have agreed that the price of the Service for the period from April 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024 is the amount specified in Paragraph 3.1. If the contract is extended, the Service provision period begins on the day following the end of the previous Service Provision Period».</p> <p>3. Paragraph 10.1. Point 10 of Contract should be set out in the following version: «10.1. This Contract shall enter into force signing by the authorized representatives of the Parties, taking into consideration paragraph 11.5, and shall be valid until April 30, 2024 in terms of provision of the Services, and until full completion in terms of acceptance of and payment for the Services.
