Re: Analytical Services Agreement

Dear Mr. Abdulmajeed,

This letter sets forth the terms of an analytical services engagement between Yorktown Solutions LLC ("Yorktown Solutions") and the American Kurdish Committee ("AKC").

Scope of Services

Yorktown Solutions will conduct a 45-day assessment evaluating the current level of awareness of the U.S.-Kurdish alliance and its importance to American national security interests among relevant U.S. audiences, and will deliver a written report of its findings to the AKC upon completion.

Term

This agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue for a period of six (6) months, unless earlier terminated in accordance with the provisions hereof.

Termination

Either party may terminate this agreement upon thirty (30) days' written notice to the other party. In the event of early termination, fees shall be prorated to the effective date of termination. Any fees paid in excess of the prorated amount shall be promptly refunded to the AKC. Any amounts owed through the termination date shall become immediately due and payable.

The fee for the initial 45-day assessment phase is \$20,000, payable as follows: \$10,000 upon execution of this agreement, and \$10,000 upon delivery of the Phase One assessment. Fees for the remainder of the six-month term shall be agreed upon in writing by the parties upon completion of the initial phase. In addition, the AKC shall reimburse Yorktown Solutions for any reasonable legal fees, filing fees, and associated costs incurred in connection with FARA registration, compliance, reporting, or any other legal or regulatory obligations arising from or related to this agreement, including any costs associated with obtaining legal counsel or advisory opinions in connection therewith. Such costs shall be invoiced to the AKC as incurred and shall be payable within fifteen (15) days of receipt of invoice. Costs that exceed \$5,000 must be approved in advance by AKC.

Representations

The parties acknowledge that this agreement is being registered by Yorktown Solutions with the U.S. Department of Justice pursuant to the Foreign Agents Registration Act (22 U.S.C. § 611 et seq.), and that the American Kurdish Committee is itself registered under FARA in connection with its activities. Each party represents and warrants that the work product produced under this agreement is intended solely to inform the AKC's own independent activities, and that neither party has entered into any side agreement or arrangement that would alter the nature of the engagement as described herein. Each party agrees to promptly notify the other if any circumstance arises that would materially affect the representations set forth in this section.

Compliance

This engagement is limited to research and analytical services. Yorktown Solutions will not conduct any activities that constitute lobbying as defined under the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 (2 U.S.C. § 1601 et seq.) or public relations counsel or publicity agent services as defined under the Foreign Agents Registration Act (22 U.S.C. § 611 et seq.), on behalf of the AKC or any foreign principal in connection with this engagement.

Confidentiality

Each party agrees to hold the other party's non-public information in strict confidence and not to disclose it to third parties without prior written consent, except as required by applicable law or regulation. For the avoidance of doubt, any obligation to register or make disclosures under FARA or other applicable law shall supersede and take precedence over this confidentiality provision.

Work Product

Upon receipt of all fees due, all right, title, and interest in the written work product produced under this agreement shall vest in the AKC. The AKC agrees that it will not share, transmit, or



otherwise disclose the written work product or any portion thereof to any foreign government, foreign political party, or instrumentality thereof, including without limitation the Kurdistan Regional Government or any ministry, agency, official, or affiliated entity thereof, without the prior express written consent of Yorktown Solutions. Prior to any other external disclosure of such work product, the AKC shall provide Yorktown Solutions reasonable advance notice and opportunity to review, and Yorktown Solutions shall have ten (10) business days to request reasonable modifications to protect its professional reputation and the integrity of its work.

Binding Agreement

This letter agreement constitutes a binding contractual obligation between Yorktown Solutions LLC and the American Kurdish Committee upon signature by both parties below. Each signatory represents that they are duly authorized to bind their respective organization. The parties acknowledge that each has had the opportunity to review this agreement with legal counsel prior to execution.
