Introduction

On the 7th of July 2018, the General Assembly of the Libyan United Democrat Party held its ordinary meeting in presence of the founding members, where Mr. Hassan Salah Eddin Tatanaki was elected Leader of the Libyan United Democrat Party.

And on 19th July 2018, the First Conference of the Libyan United Democrat Party was held and attended by 1260 delegated members and 34 civil society organizations. The Conference was crowned by the entry into a coalition agreement by and between the Libyan Democratic Assembly and some civil society organizations.

The Libyan United Democrat Party has opened 4 main branches in the Central Region, Greater Tripoli Region, the Western Region, and the



Western Mountain Region, and 54 offices affiliated to the main branches.

The number of Libyan United Democrat Party supporters and affiliates has so far reached 68,000.

Activities of the Libyan United Democrat Party

1- The Libyan United Democrat Party, Main Press Conference Held in Cairo

This press conference was held on 6th October 2018 in presence of 34 civil society organizations and a number of political entities and social components and attended by 230 persons.

The conference was concluded by a final communiqué in which the attendees recommended the following:



1. The elections are the only solution to end the state of political division and unite the institutions and restore security and economic stability in the country
2. The parties are to reactivate the constitutional rule and the 1963 Constitution and allow the Constitutional Department of the Supreme Court to make the necessary amendments to such Constitution
3. The parties are to fight administrative and financial corruption, and hold accountable all those involved in financial corruption known as “money dawaish”
4. The parties are to support the judicial institution and the police to achieve security and safety in the country
5. The parties are to alleviate the suffering of Libyan people by providing the basic commodities such as government subsidized foodstuff and medicine.

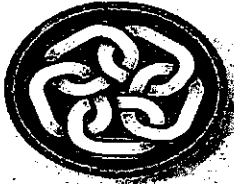


2- The Libyan Party Peace Festival

This Festival was held in November 2018 by the Libyan United Democrat Party under the slogan “Peace Stems from Inside” in the Royal Palace in Tripoli City, with the participation of 61 civil society organizations. The number of people who attended the Festival in three days reached some 5600 attendees. The Festival opening was attended by a number of national elites from the State Council, leaders of parties, and former and incumbent ministers and was aimed at uniting Libyans for love and peace without consideration to ethnicity, whereabouts, or republic affiliation. The festival had great impact of the Libyan social environment.

3- Jarmah Tourism Festival

The Libyan United Democrat Party has participated in Jarmah Tourism Festival organized in December 2018 in Ubari City locate in the southern part of Libya by mobilization of a caravan formed of 25 Libyan families from Tripoli to attend the Festival as a supporting move by the Libyan



citizens living in the western parts of the Libyan territories to the Libyan citizens living in the south as a sign that Libya is united and can bring all Libyans together.

4- The First Forum of the Coalition of National Unity

The Libyan United Democrat Party invited the political entities, social society components, syndicates, and unions to hold a meeting in Tripoli in January 2019 to unite their efforts and bring all these components together into a single weft named the Coalition of National Unity and coalition agreement was signed by:

1. 25 political parties
2. 61 civil society organizations
3. 6 unions

The abovementioned attendees agreed to hold the first forum of the Coalition of National Unity in Tunis so that all Libyans living in Tunisia



could attend it and participate therein and be integrated in political work under the principle of fate determination.

Conclusion

The objective of founding the Coalition of National Unity is the following:

1. unite the efforts of national parties, independent elites, civil society organizations, and unions and bring them together into a single entity acting against the political Islam parties and the entities built on regional and ethnic affiliation who often preach nothing but division and maintaining the state of chaos and political impasse from which the country has been suffering for years.
2. call for parliamentary and presidential elections as they are the only solution to end the state of political division and chaos, while enhancing the Libyan people awareness and educating them in this regard.



3. fill in the political vacuum and anarchy prevailing in the country after the national parties failed to conform the political Islam parties and other extremists.

Communication

The United Nations Support Mission in Libya and its affiliated HD Organization in the Libyan Democratic Assembly have communicated and visited the Assembly's headquarters and met with the Political Administration and the Secretary General on two separate meetings and discussed the main events concerning the national issue and the Assembly's vision regarding the solution, and made suggestions in that respect, where the main focus of the meeting was the mass forum intended to be held. The Secretariat General of the Assembly emphasized that the only solution to the political crisis in Libya is the actualization of parliamentary and presidential elections and revival of the 1963 Constitution after making the necessary amendments thereto.

5- The First Conference of the Libyan United Democrat Party in Tunis

In January 2019 the First Conference of the Libyan United Democrat Party was held in presence of 25 political parties, 17 syndicates and unions, a number of civil society organizations, and more than 170 independent figures such as senate members, chiefs of tribes, and Libyan civil society components. The Forum lasted for 2 days and concluded its agenda by drawing up a communiqué of 7 items. The attendees agreed to hold the second conference in Tripoli in February 2019 under the following agenda:

1. Elect the President of the Coalition of National Unity.
2. Prepare a political communiqué for the Coalition of National Unity
(General Assembly)
3. Decide on the organizational structure of the Coalition of National
Unity.



4. Participate in the mass forum and provide the Assembly vision and its mechanism of application.

Statement of Coalition of National Unity on rescuing Libya of the ongoing situation of political stalemate

The national forces in a strong system tend with complete objectivity to adopt the best options and to succeed them in rescuing Libya of the situations of political stalemate and the ongoing failures that threaten the Libyan people and the safety of the homeland and its whole future and destroy its institutions and abort its prestige in an unprecedented manner.

We, the national forces, are represented in a number of political entities, rallies, parties, currents, movements, some of the civil society institutions, and some syndicates and federations, as well as prominent independent political figures, having carefully studied all the situations that have led Libya to this present subject matter and to what we are suffering today of undermining the security and stability under strenuous and continuous transitional stages which we must overcome to build the state in accordance with the correct and serious pillars and foundations, therefore we hereby declare our adoption of the following rights and duties:

1. Establishing a constitutional basis for organizing the preparatory stage and to benefit from the constitutional legacy and Libyan law until a permanent constitution for the state is established.
2. The agreement on a timetable for presidential and parliamentary elections by the end of May 2019 as maximum, with the participation of the political parties and blocs and under the control of the United Nations, the Organization of the European Union, the League of Arab States and the African Union, and under the supervision of the Libyan judiciary and obliging all to accept their outputs and results.
3. Forming a strong national unity government supported by the both Libyan and international communities to manage the affairs of the state and conduct business until the completion of the elections.
4. Supporting the independence of the judiciary and maintain its prestige.

5. Reparations and compensation of the migrants and displaced persons for their material and moral losses.
6. Ascertaining of the review and audit of the previous budgets of the State from year 2011 to 2018 by specialized bodies, and international and local experts to recover the looted funds.
7. The participants in the meeting of the Coalition of National Unity stressed the importance of coordination with the United Nations Support Mission in Libya for the contribution of the Coalition of National Unity in the collective Forum as effective political and civil forces.

The national forces call upon our Libyan people to move forward towards strengthening, mobilizing and gathering the ranks through the legitimate and legal means and the continuous political action so that the demands can be fulfilled and to achieve and build a respectful and dignified Libyan state and among the developed countries well-deservedly.

May God keep our country dear, precious and victorious, and may God save our dear people.
