HAVILA SUBSEA	Offshore Supply Ship	Norway	Owner HAVILA SHIPPING ASA (on a long term charter with MMT Sweden)	On February 24, the vessel came to the port of Mukran from the territorial waters of Denmark. Since February 24 it is in the construction NS2 zone NS2 in the territorial waters of Germany.
