“The certification process has taken a long time, and this issue has been one of the objectives of gas sector reform for the past 11 years. Thanks to dedicated work and excellent cooperation between Transportgas, Srbijagas and the Energy Agency, we have managed to complete this challenging process, thereby fulfilling all the requirements set by the European Commission,” said Energy Minister Dubravka Đedović Handanović.

The Minister met with the newly elected Director of Transportgas Srbija, Zoran Jovčić, and discussed further key reforms in the gas sector that must be completed by June this year. She emphasised the importance of strengthening Transportgas Srbija’s capacities and enhancing its role in the energy system, both in terms of security of supply and the implementation of new gas sector projects.

Representatives of Transportgas Srbija informed the Minister about the company’s short- and long-term operational priorities, highlighting, among other things, the need to amend the collective agreement and modernise the gas transmission system.
