THIS CONTRACT OF SHIZUOKA TOURISM REPRESENTATION IN THE USA, hereinafter referred to as "The Contract", is made and entered into by and between Shizuoka Prefectural Tourism Association, hereinafter referred to as "The Association" and MMGY Global, LLC, hereinafter referred to as "MMGY Global," for the purpose described as below. All dates referred to in this Contract shall be based on Japan Standard Time (JST), unless otherwise stated.

Terms and Conditions

- 1 MMGY Global hereby commits preferential support to encourage, among specified tourists in the USA, Shizuoka Prefecture as a destination in Japan with the proviso as below;
 - 1) MMGY Global is to accomplish tourism promotional services such as;
 - * If the implementation of items (a)–(e) results in costs exceeding the contract amount, any such excess costs shall, upon prior consultation with the Association, be paid separately.
 - (a) Public relations with US media and trade
 - (b) To distribute quarterly trade newsletters to travel advisors the network and to respond to enquiries regarding to Shizuoka tourism
 - (c) Attend and support trade shows and events
 - (d) To conduct biannual webinars to trade advisor audience
 - (e) To help arrangement when either the Association or Shizuoka-based businesses visit the USA for promotion business or the Association invites agencies for fam trip
- 2 MMGY Global is to submit 4 quarterly business activity reports in the format mutually agreed upon by both parties by the date as below. The language used is to be English.

For April - June	by July 10, 2026
For July – September	by October 9, 2026
For October - December	by January 8, 2027
For January - March	on March 30, 2027
- 3 MMGY Global is to have 4 video meetings or more with the Association for information sharing purposes. The language used is to be English.
- 4 MMGY Global is to consider other relevant works, which may subject to additional fees, when agreed between the parties.

Term of the Contract

- 1 This contract shall be valid from April 1, 2026 to March 31, 2027. However, either party may terminate the contract by providing 30 days' prior notice and obtaining mutual consent.

Payment

- 1 The amount of The Contract is to be agreed as below with the consent of both parties and any additional charge shall not be granted unless otherwise approved in advance by The Association.
 - 1) The Association shall pay a total amount of 41,580 US\$ to MMGY Global for The Contract.
 - 2) The payment will be planned as below when regular reports are deemed eligible.

For April - June	10,395 US\$ billed in June
For July - September	10,395 US \$ billed in July
For October - December	10,395 US \$ billed in October
For January - March	10,395 US \$ billed on March 30, 2027
 - 3) The Association is to finish payment within 30 days after receiving the invoice.
The remittance charge is to be incurred by The Association.

Other Conditions

- 1) When The Contract needs changed, The Association or MMGY Global is to submit it in written form. Any changes must be made in writing and mutually executed.
- 2) MMGY Global shall indemnify The Association against any liability for serious damage or loss caused by MMGY Global to third parties, except where the loss or damage is caused:
 - (a) by inaccurate information supplied by The Association to MMGY Global or from use by MMGY Global of information or material supplied by the Association
 - (b) by use of material that has been signed off or approved by The Association
 - (c) by any activity where MMGY Global was acting on instructions from The Association
 - (d) directly or indirectly from The Association's failure or delay to perform any of its obligations or by any act or omission of The Association
- 3) The Association has the right to discharge The Contract when reasons as below arises.
 - (a) When found a breach of The Contract.
 - (b) When The Contract becomes meaningless or purposeless according to the unanticipated disasters or drastic changes of each party.
- 4) During the duration of the Agreement, the Company shall be an independent contractor and nothing in this Agreement shall mean that MMGY Global acts as the Association's agent nor creates a partnership or joint venture of any kind between the parties.
