Ahead of May Day, I wanted to see if you would be interested in speaking with workers, activists, and leaders of the Cambodia National Rescue Movement. As in years past, Cambodian officials have denied permits for a May Day march, adding to the growing list of attacks on workers' rights. **Still, thousands of workers are set to take to the streets to make sure their voice is heard.**

Hun Sen's attacks on freedom of association and freedom of speech have restricted the ability of labor unions to organize, carry out basic governance and representative functions, and even maintain their legal status.
