

Independent Intelligence Agency, LLC was awarded an "Appointment/Mandate" on May 25, 2017 by the President of the State of Galmudug, Somalia for Independent Intelligence Agency, LLC a Florida company registered with the United States Federal Government as a private contractor, including all its agents and representatives, to act as the sole agent, analyst, advisor, advocate, consultant, lobbyist, mediator, and negotiator on behalf of Galmudug, Somalia to aid The Honorable Ahmed Dual Gelle in providing services for humanitarian and infrastructural development of the region. This also includes consulting in all political matters as requested or needed by the President of the State of Galmudug, Somalia. (PLEASE SEE ATTACHED "APPOINTMENT/MANDATE").

Prior to registration, our company, on the advice and request of the President of Galmudug, was asked to inform other governmental and private entities of the existing opportunities in the State of Galmudug as to infrastructural development, humanitarian services, and agricultural and natural resources available in the region. We followed through his request and communicated via telephone and e-mails. At no time has any compensation, monetary or otherwise, been paid or awarded our company, or individually/personally.

To aid the President of the State of Galmudug, Somalia, The Honorable Ahmed Dual Gelle "Haaf" in matters relating to business, humanitarian, infrastructure development, lobbying, advising, analyst, consulting, mediation, negotiation, and political matters to enhance the region, and if needed or requested by the President, to meet with business or governmental officials/entities on his behalf and for the people of the State of Galmudug, Somalia and the surrounding regions.



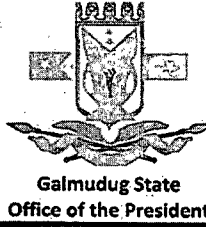

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that effective May 23, 2017, I, The H.E. Ahmed Duale Gelle, the newly appointed leader of Galmudug, Somalia, duly appoint Independent Intelligence Agency, LLC ("IIA"), a Florida company registered with the United States Federal Government as a private contractor, including all its agents and representatives, to act as the sole agent, analyst, advisor, consultant, lobbyist, mediator, and negotiator on behalf of Galmudug, Somalia and to aid The Honorable Ahmed Duale Gelle and provide services as further described below. All privileges and rights attached to this Appointment and Mandate will be honored, respected, and recognized by all foreign and domestic governmental entities and all private organizations. All matters including, but not limited to, information and intelligence gathering, analytical studies, consulting, mediation, and business involvements and opportunities which currently exist within the governing sector for which this Appointment has been rendered and executed must be addressed with the Head Analyst, Advisor, Consultant, Lobbyist, Mediator and Negotiator for IIA. Independent Intelligence Agency, LLC is bound by the law. Both IIA and any participating government or private entity must adhere to all national and international laws as applicable during their duties and performance.

This Appointment and Mandate, as issued and executed, will be for IIA's full involvement in all governmental issues which include, analysis, advising, consulting, lobbying, mediation and negotiations for any governmental matters, business purposes and opportunities, and for any other reasons or issues which require the full attention and involvement of IIA on behalf and for Galmudug, Somalia.

All privileges of this Appointment and Mandate should be recognized, honored, and respected by governmental entities including military sectors, intelligence sectors, defense departments, and the United Nations, including any foreign investment entities or organizations that wish to have any involvement in this region of Somalia. This will be applicable to all NATO participating countries wishing to aid in the development of Galmudug, Somalia, and for all matters or issues referenced in this Mandate.

This Appointment and Mandate shall remain valid and in full force and effect until otherwise determined in writing by all parties involved.
