



*The budget presented is based on initial venue outreach and estimates. Upon signing of agreement we will develop a full budget that includes all costs. This will include additional items requested such as event photographer, decor, etc.

Hard costs, including Myriad team travel, will be billed on actuals and provided to the client for prior approval. MMGY Myriad will be sure to work with Turismo de Albufeira and partners to ensure the venue selected and other elements are within the approved budget. We will provide three venue options in each location for consideration..

Travel costs for participating partners are not included with the exception of bus transfer between Boston and New York.



Payment Terms:
MMGY Myriad will require 50% of the fee due up front to commence work. The balance will be due upon completion of the event.
In terms of payment for the hard costs, we will pass on vendor payment terms to the client. We would expect most vendor costs to be due prior to the event, including venue deposits which are typically due upon signing of agreements. We will provide the client with these details along with backup invoicing and agreements as needed.
