(Provisional English translation)

June 1, 2018

1. Objective

In view of the critical importance of the Japan-U.S. relationship, we seek to establish a new framework for dialogue between a nonpartisan group of legislators from Japan and the U.S., and to strengthen the foundation of, and further deepen the mid- to long-term bilateral relationship.

2. Subject Matter

- The immediate subjects shall be national security and trade/economic relations.
- While we proceed under the assumption of operating the program under the current U.S. administration, our intent is to perpetuate it beyond that.
