Short Form Engagement Agreement

This short form engagement agreement ("the Agreement") is made on the date of full execution by the parties below by and between:

Economic Development Board, a Bahraini governmental body established pursuant to Legislative Decree No. 9 of 2000 (as amended), having its offices in Manama, P.O. Box 11299, Kingdom of Bahrain (herein referred to as 'the Client'); and

APCO Worldwide Co. SPC owned by APCO Foreign Holdings LLC, having commercial registration number 124945-1 and its registered offices at office 2950, United Tower, Level 29, Building 316, Road 4609, Manama/Sea Front, Kingdom of Bahrain (herein referred to as 'the Agency').

The Client and the Agency each may be referred to herein, individually, as a "Party" and collectively, as the "Parties".

WHEREAS:

- A. The Client wishes to procure an agreed amount of strategic communications, media relations and social media services within the United States ("the Services").
- B. The Agency undertakes that it has the ability to provide the Services to the Client.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants and undertakings expressed herein, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The Agency shall provide the Services to the Client from October 7, 2020 to October 7, 2021 ("the Term").
2. The Client shall pay the Agency a fixed monthly fee of BHD 1,872 (One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy Two Bahraini Dinars Only), inclusive of all applicable taxes ("the Monthly Fee").
3. The Monthly Fee shall be paid monthly in arrears by the Client to the Agency within thirty (30) days from the receipt of a valid invoice from the Agency.
