Dear H.E. Ambassador Szabó:

Munk Policy & Law is pleased to have the opportunity to represent the Embassy of Hungary. Thank you for selecting me. Our relationship will be governed by this letter.

Contractual Duties

You have asked me to represent you on US State Department lobbying (the "Matter") from November 7, 2018 to January 21, 2019. In fulfilling these duties, I undertake to provide services using the highest standard of professional diligence and care with an active, continuous effort throughout the term of this engagement acting for the Embassy of Hungary only, and am not acting as counsel to any employee of the Embassy of Hungary, or undertaking any duties or responsibilities to any such person

Compensation Arrangements

I will invoice you twice, first within ten working days following the submission of the first report after December 21, 2018, and then within ten working days following the submission of the final comprehensive report. Each invoice will be for \$25,000, for a total of \$50,000, plus any travel costs outside the Washington area. This flat fee covers all expenses, except travel outside the Washington area on behalf of the Embassy that shall only be made with advance approval by the Embassy. No charges shall be made for travel within the Washington area. Payment will be made in US dollars, and in line of the tax exempt status of the Embassy of Hungary as a diplomatic mission. I will provide a preliminary report of my work on the matter on or about December 21, 2018, and a final report after completion of the contract. If these reports show that the work to date has been satisfactorily carried out, the Embassy of Hungary will certify completion and authorize payment for my services which payments shall be made within 10 business days following certification of completion. In the event after receiving either reports, the Embassy of Hungary does not feel that Munk Policy & Law has provided services at the volume or caliber that it expected, it may request supplemental information or corrective action.

Termination

Either party may terminate this contract for non-performance or other cause on thirty days notice. Upon termination, services provided to date shall be compensated based on the steps completed as shown in the preliminary report and final reports, and certified as completed by the Embassy.

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Conflicts

I represent that I do not have any legal conflicts with handling this matter as of November 6, 2018, and will notify the Embassy if a conflict may arise. However, Munk Policy & Law agrees that it will not represent other parties in a federal agency matter directly adverse to the Embassy of Hungary or advocate contrary positions before the same body or agency on the same issue.

Miscellaneous Provisions

To safeguard the trust you have given me, I will take all reasonable precautions—treating your confidential materials like its my own—to keep that information safe, and will not share it with others unless I have the Hungarian Embassy's express consent or instruction to do so, or are required by the courts or applicable laws and regulations to do so.

Munk Policy & Law shall be solely responsible for compliance with any and all federal, state, county, and local laws, rules and/or regulations, and lawful orders of public authorities and that, in any manner that could bear on the services provided in this agreement. I will also fully comply with all applicable US Federal lobbying laws, including the Foreign Agents Registration Act ("FARA"), which includes disclosure of our engagement contract, my fee, my activities on Hungary's behalf, and informational papers that I prepare and distribute. Where it does not conflict with FARA, I will maintain Hungary's confidences as stated in the request for proposal.

I may involve other lawyers and paraprofessionals as needed to execute my assignments.

You acknowledge that you have had the opportunity to consult, to the extent you deem advisable, with your in-house counsel or US counsel other than me in reviewing and agreeing to this engagement agreement and the consents contained herein.

If the terms and scope of our engagement outlined in this letter are acceptable to you, please so indicate by signing below. I look forward to working on your behalf.
