



Dear Dr. Basdeo:

This letter is to document the representation of the Ministry of Financial Services & Commerce of the Cayman Islands Government ("the Ministry") by Munk Policy & Law ("I" or "MP&L"), and their successors and assigns. Thank you for your continued confidence in my work.

You have asked me and I have agreed to personally represent the Ministry with respect to the Ministry's education and advocacy program in Washington, DC, by providing counseling and advocacy services on international taxation and financial services legislative and public policy matters before the United States Congress and the Executive Branch (the "Matter"). I am acting for the Ministry only and am not acting as counsel to any employee or officer of the Ministry, or undertaking any legal duties or responsibilities to any such person.

Term

The initial term of this contract (as an interim measure) shall run from October 14, 2024, to October 31, 2024. This is in order to facilitate the preparation of a more formal type of Consultancy Agreement, between the Parties, which will be legally binding. The terms of this contract may continue monthly from November 1, 2024, pending the completion of the formal type of Consultancy Agreement. The Consultancy Agreement will be superior to and supersede this document (which is only intended to be an interim holding measure).

Compensation Arrangements

I agree to handle the Matter for the fixed monthly amount of \$20,000 per month, plus expenses, including compliance with U.S. Foreign Agent Registration Act ("FARA") costs and any travel costs outside of the Washington DC area at the Ministry's request. For the initial term of the contract in October 2024, I agree to handle the Matter for a fee of \$10,000. All fees shall be payable in US dollars, and net of any business, withholding, sales, or value-added taxes in the US or Cayman. If such a tax is applied the payment shall be grossed up for fees and costs. The monthly fee and expenses will be billed on a monthly basis, and will be considered earned as they are incurred. You agree that the monthly fee is not subject to any refund or adjustment if you terminate your representation, and that the monthly fee is reasonable for the services provided. If the scope of the Matter is substantially increased or broadened at your request, for the Ministry or another unit of the Cayman Islands Government, you agree to pay reasonable fees for the increased or broadened work by adjusting the monthly fee.

Conflicts

I represent that I do not have any legal conflicts with handling this matter as of October 22, 2024, and will promptly notify the Ministry if a conflict arises.

Miscellaneous Provisions


I will comply with all applicable US Federal lobbying laws, including FARA, which includes disclosure of our engagement contract, my fee, my political activities on the Ministry's behalf, and informational papers that I prepare and distribute. Where it does not conflict with FARA, I will maintain the Ministry's confidences.

I may involve other lawyers and paraprofessionals as needed to execute my assignments.

You acknowledge that you have had the opportunity to consult, to the extent you deem advisable, with your in-house counsel or US counsel other than me in reviewing and agreeing to this engagement agreement and the consents contained herein.



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
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
