MediaLinks TV, LLC ("MediaLinks") is an indirect subsidiary of CCTV and has assumed responsibility for all the services and activities previously performed by CGTN America, which was an unincorporated unit of CCTV. Like CGTN America before it, MediaLinks acts as the Washington news bureau of CCTV. CCTV, through a division it has named the China Global Television Network ("CGTN"), offers multi-language news channels internationally, including a 24-hour English-language news channel that is broadcast to over 100 countries, including the United States. MediaLinks will enter into a contract with CCTV, whereby MediaLinks will agree to provide news media and television production services (primarily in Washington, DC) for programs to be broadcast on CGTN, which will include providing all the facilities, equipment and staff necessary to implement, manage and perform such services, and whereby CCTV will agree to compensate MediaLinks on an arm's length basis in accordance with United States and People's Republic of China transfer pricing rules for providing such services. When this contract is in final form and is executed by the parties to it, a copy will be submitted to accompany this Exhibit B. In any event, all receipts received and all disbursements made by MediaLinks will be duly reported in Supplemental Statements as required by FARA.

As explained in regard to item 11 in the Registration Statement filed by CGTN America (now MediaLinks), the Department of Justice's FARA Unit has stated that "'bona fide news or journalistic activities' are not exempt from the statute's [i.e., FARA's] reach unless they are undertaken by organizations in the United States that are controlled by U.S. citizens"; and that "the registration requirement does not depend on the accuracy of reporting, or the viewpoint (or viewpoints) expressed," but it does depend on whether the organization "intends to influence the American public and policy makers on relevant topics" (termed "political activities" in FARA), "regardless of whether it is also 'balanced' or aims to balance reporting by other networks." In light of these considerations, the FARA Unit concluded that CGTN America -- now MediaLinks -- engages in "political activities" as defined by FARA.

Footnote: "Political activity," as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act, means any activity which the person engaging in believes will, or that the person intends to, in any way influence any agency or official of the Government of the United States or any section of the public within the United States with reference to formulating, adopting, or changing the domestic or foreign policies of the United States or with reference to the political or public interests, policies, or relations of a government of a foreign country or a foreign political party.

Attachment to MediaLinks TV, LLC Exhibit B

MediaLinks TV, LLC ("MediaLinks"), using the CGTN America brand name, works in tandem with CGTN news bureaus in Nairobi and Beijing to produce news programming for CGTN's 24-hour English-language broadcasts. MediaLinks strives to offer audiences (including the U.S. audience) news coverage of world events from a perspective that is not Western-centric. In doing so, MediaLinks performs its news gathering and reporting activities like those of other Washington news bureaus, including those of other foreign news organizations that broadcast or publish in the United States. MediaLinks's news gathering and production activities are performed by professional journalists from approximately 36 countries, regions, and ethnicities. To enhance its news coverage, there are commercial arrangements with a number of news services such as AP, CNN, and Reuters. The news programs currently produced by MediaLinks are as follows: World Today, Global Business, The Heat, China 24 (America), Full Frame, and Americas Now. These programs are aired in the U.S. during a designated time slot for MediaLinks under the CGTN America brand name. Programs produced by MediaLinks are transmitted to CCTV/CGTN in Beijing, which re-transmits the programs on its CGTN international channel to television broadcasters/cable providers for dissemination to local audiences around the world, including the United States. In addition, MediaLinks (using the CGTN America brand name) hosts a website and various social media sites that are accessible in the United States. These sites are listed in the Registration Statement filed for CGTN America/MediaLinks at Part V, Item 15.
