Pursuant to the Agreement by and between the Aruba Tourism Authority (“Client”) and Zeno Group, Inc. **SCOPE OF SERVICES**

Agency shall not exceed the total budget amount unless approved in writing, it being understood that amounts may be shifted between fees and expenses, so long as the total budget is not exceeded.
