Dear Your Excellency,

The firm of Fein & DelValle PLLC proposes the following terms and conditions for our representation of you in the United States and in international forums to obtain official recognition that you are the authentic President of Nigeria based on an accurate counting of legal ballots cast on February 23, 2019.




