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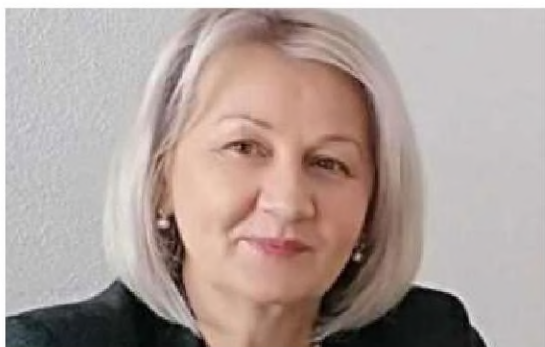
Milorad Dodik, the leader of the SNSD and President of BiH's Republika Srpska (RS) entity, said that it is regretful that there was a delay in reforms after BiH was granted EU candidate status, and that now the country is in a situation "that calls for solutions".

"I believe that the locals should solve these issues. We are ready to refer some of the laws to the Parliament of BiH for it to decide and see how we can unblock the European path again", he said after the meeting.
