

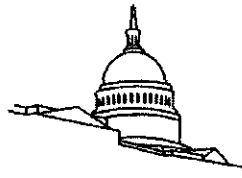

Some of the services M&M will provide under this engagement will include:


- Regular reports on developments in Washington, DC on issues of importance to Greece;

M&M will commence work upon the date of the signature of this letter of agreement. The term will be twelve (12) months, unless renewed in writing. Each of the Parties reserves the right to terminate this agreement upon thirty days' written notice. All documents generated in the course of the representation shall be property of the Ministry.


