Dear Ambassador Koonjul,

This letter serves to extend the existing May 20, 2019 Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Mauritius ("Mauritius") and McLarty Inbound ("MI") to assist Mauritius in its efforts to exercise its sovereignty over the Chagos Archipelago and having such sovereignty recognized by the UK and US.

The Agreement shall be extended for an additional six (6) month period, from January 1, 2021 to June 30, 2021. As compensation for MI's services, Mauritius agrees to pay MI: 1) a monthly retainer fee of \$35,000, due at the beginning of each month; 2) reimbursement of pre-approved out-of-pocket expenses, typically travel-related and including business class for all international travel. MI will obtain approval from Mauritius for travel related expenses prior to incurring any such costs.

Any further extensions following the expiration of this additional period of engagement shall be at the discretion of Mauritius.

It is agreed that all other terms of the May 20, 2019 Agreement shall remain in force and effect.
