Thanks for the update. KLK confirmed this with us earlier in the week, and their decision is now on KLK's public grievance log.

How will P&G ensure that all its 1<sup>st</sup> tier suppliers do not supply Samling palm oil to P&G's supply chain in the future? For example, other companies are informing all their 1<sup>st</sup> tier suppliers of their 'No Purchase' decisions, i.e. formally asking their suppliers not to supply Samling palm oil to them.

Also, thank you for informing us of P&G's internal grievance log. We encourage you to make this grievance log public to enhance transparency of the actions that P&G is taking to resolve any NDPE violations, as other companies have done. Is that something P&G would consider?
