Global America Business Institute (GABI) – Florence Lowe Lee (FLL) has been engaged by the Korean Atomic Energy Research Institute (KAERI) to provide, as an independent contractor, educational, government relations and consulting services and have registered with the Department of Justice, pursuant to the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended. (Registration Number 6067)

With this agreement, GABI and FLL is engaging Farragut Partners to provide as a subcontractor certain of the services that are to be provided by GABI and FLL to the Korean Atomic Energy Research Institute. The services to be provided by Farragut Partners consist of facilitating discussion and an agreement between the Department of Energy and KAERI relating to research and development of the Versatile Test Reactor Program for the purpose of ultimately performing irradiation testing at much higher neutron energy fluxes than what is currently available today.

The term of Farragut's engagement as a subcontractor is January 15, 2020 until April 1, 2020. As compensation for the services rendered by Farragut Partners during the period of your engagement, GABI-FLL will pay Farragut Partners the sum of \$30,000 to be payable by the last day of January 2020.

The relationship between GABI-FLL and you will be that of independent contractor and not of partners, joint ventures', principal and agent or otherwise. Without the prior consent of the other, neither party will be authorized to bind or obligate the other or, except as provided herein to act for or on behalf of the other.


