Provision of the information requested is mandatory, and failure to provide the information is subject to the penalty and enforcement provisions established in Section 8 of the Act. Every registration statement, short form registration statement, supplemental statement, exhibit, amendment, copy of informational materials or other document or information filed with the Attorney General under this Act is a public record open to public examination, inspection and copying during the posted business hours of the FARA Unit in Washington, DC. One copy of every such document, other than informational materials, is automatically provided to the Secretary of State pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Act, and copies of any and all documents are routinely made available to other agencies, departments and Congress pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Act. The Attorney General also transmits a semi-annual report to Congress on the administration of the Act which lists the names of all agents registered under the Act and the foreign principals they represent. Response to Item 11

Question 11: Describe in detail all services which you will render to the foreign principal listed in Item 10 either directly, or through the primary registrant listed in Item 8

For Mr. Reinaldo Munoz Pedroza, Mr. Kise will provide the Foreign Principal with legal services authorized by the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control ("OFAC") pursuant to 31 C.F.R. §591.506(a) (the "General License"), to the extent that such authorization is applicable or required. These legal services will include legal advice and counseling on the requirements of and compliance with the laws of the United States or any jurisdiction within the United States, representing the Foreign Principal in legal, administrative, or other proceedings occurring before U.S. courts and administrative agencies, and other activities authorized by the General License that may become necessary from time to time.

These legal services will likely include: (i) a review of Foreign Principal files, publicly available documents, and/or interviews necessary to advise the Foreign Principal on the requirements of and compliance with laws of the United States, including the various economic sanctions OFAC and other U.S. Government authorities have imposed or may impose against the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela (the "Republic") and related parties; (ii) advising the Foreign Principal regarding the scope and nature of OFAC and other U.S. economic sanctions programs that are or may be imposed against the Republic and related parties; (iii) developing a strategy to approach the U.S. Government in support of delisting the Foreign Principal or other parties subject to U.S. economic sanctions due to their connections to the Republic; and (iv) representing the Foreign Principal in initial discussions with officials at OFAC and other U.S. Government agencies regarding U.S. economic sanctions against the Republic and certain related parties.
