

Study on effectiveness of mRNA vaccine boosters

Hi X,

New research coming out of Weill Cornell Medicine-Qatar, located in Qatar Foundation's Education City, is focused on the effectiveness of mRNA vaccine boosters. Findings show booster effectiveness of only about 50% against symptomatic Omicron variant infection, but much higher effectiveness against severe cases of COVID-19.

The research will be published in the New England Journal of Medicine **today, Wednesday March 9th, at 5pm ET**. If you are interested and agree to the embargo, I am happy to share the full findings.
