I would like to invite you to a virtual discussion with social justice advocate Lina Abu Akleh next Monday, October 31st at 9am ET / 4pm Doha, hosted by Qatar Foundation's Education City Speaker Series (ECSS). Titled "Protecting Truth, Seeking Justice" and moderated by Al Jazeera journalist Jamal Elshayyal, the conversation will explore activism and the communication of true and fake narratives in the information age – and how journalists reporting the truth amid danger can be protected.

As you may know, Lina Abu Akleh is campaigning for justice for her aunt, Shireen Abu Akleh, the Al Jazeera journalist who was killed while reporting on an Israeli military raid in Palestine earlier this year. Among the topics discussed:

- What it takes to be an activist and a seeker of justice in today's world – and how it is changing
- How the Information Age both supports and hinders the spread of truthful narratives
- The challenges of making your voice heard as an activist among the noise of the modern world
