**SATURDAY: Embassy of Qatar and World Central Kitchen Continue Ramadan Partnership with Meal Deliveries to Los Angeles-Area Seniors**

LOS ANGELES — Representatives from the **Embassy of the State of Qatar** to the United States and acclaimed Chef José Andrés' **World Central Kitchen** (WCK) will deliver meals to Los Angeles residents on Saturday. This is a part of an ongoing partnership between the Embassy and WCK to celebrate Ramadan — a month-long moment for reflection, self-awareness, and philanthropy and a time to encourage that spirit of giving and charity around the world. This week's meal deliveries are part of a larger effort to deliver 5,000 meals to those in need in Los Angeles this spring.

Diplomats, World Central Kitchen volunteers, and restaurant staff will prepare and package food at **Hot & Cool Cafe** before commencing delivery of 650 meals to South Los Angeles residents receiving COVID-19 vaccinations.
